

Geoff Lindey biography

After reading Mathematical Science at Edinburgh University, Geoff Lindey joined the Scottish Life Assurance Company where he qualified as an actuary. After periods at Henderson Administration and NM Rothschild Asset Management, Geoff joined JPMorgan Investment Management in September 1989 as Head of UK Institutional Investment. He retired at the end of March 2003. Throughout his 13 years at JPMorgan, Geoff chaired the International Proxy Committee.

Geoff was a member of the Council of the Faculty of Actuaries and the Greenbury Committee and was also a member of the first "Myners Committee" whose report was published as "Developing a Winning Partnership". He was until September 2002 Chairman of the FT-SE Actuaries Share Indices Steering Committee.

Geoff was Strategic Advisor on Corporate Governance to the NAPF from the beginning of April 2003 to mid-2005 and is a Trustee or Advisor to five major British pension funds.
