Following a successful pilot, we are increasing the number of members in the working group as we increase the size and scope of the programme.

Purpose of CFA UK Mentoring Programme working group

The working group is responsible for overseeing the strategic direction and administration of the CFA UK Mentoring offering which currently runs annually. Applications for the 2020 programme are provisionally scheduled to open in December 2019. This is a great opportunity to directly impact the professional development of CFA UK members.

Main activities:

- Sustained delivery of the Mentoring offering
 - Setting the programme criteria and deadlines, advertising to members and streamlining processes.
- Administration of the programme
 - Reviewing applications, matching participants, monitoring progress, and reviewing and incorporating feedback.
- Marketing to increase member awareness of the CFA UK Mentoring Programme
 - Promoting the programme to members through organising events and social media channels.
- Improve use of IT and systems
 - Increase the efficiency of the application and matching process.
- Implement, deliver and improve training for participants, with focus on Mentors

 Provide ongoing support to participants.

Who are we looking for:

- Enthusiastic members who can strengthen and continue the delivery of the programme.
- Availability for around eight meetings throughout the membership year with a busy period between January and April plus work to move ideas forward between meetings.
- Ability to work with a group to shape ideas.
- Members with experience of participating in Mentoring programmes (not essential).
