The CFA UK Performance & Risk Special Interest Group (PRSIG) exists to inform the Society and the wider financial community about the topic of risk management. - Willing to be responsive and creative in finding new ways of engaging the SIG membership

- LG members will need to be able to jointly express a vision for the SIG and develop an annual operating plan and a long-term plan for the SIG with the others on the LG team

How the CFA UK will help:

- The CFA UK will host one event each year for the SIG, including working out all the logistics (booking the venue, etc.). The LG will be responsible for sourcing the venues for and hosting the other events during the year.
- For all PRSIG events, the CFA UK can provide marketing to the Society's wider membership via the events listing and emails
- The Society can also provide support with technical operations for webinars
- In the long term the CFA UK will provide an online community platform that can be used as a tool to help build the SIG's network

- Develop leadership, communication and team work skills
- Recognition for your contribution in shaping and delivering services to the membership
- Opportunity to meet and network with other like-minded investment professionals
