Manager Research encompasses investment professionals working within various fields, from Pension funds, Consultancies and Fund of Funds to Private Banks and Wealth Advisers. This Special Interest Group aims to build a community of Manager Research professionals interested in networking with like-minded peers and developing professionally, providing them with a space to share ideas and content. The Manager Research SIG also aims to promote and deliver events and content (mainly through online forums and research) geared at bettering the understanding of issues and challenges facing Manager Research professionals in the UK.

Purpose and activities:

- Help to build the Manager Research SIG community and facilitate networking between members.
- Assess topics that would be of most interest to the membership and help to design a portfolio of events and content for Manager Research professionals.
- Create and promote content and research papers/ articles relevant to Manager Research Professionals.
- Organise events (e.g. discussion panels, pub meets, speaker events) around themes of interest to Manager Research Professionals.
- Bring forward new ideas to generate higher engagement rates for the Manager Research SIG.

Who are we looking for?

- Has a good understanding of Manager Research across a broad range of strategies (ideally a practitioner in Manager Research).
- Available for six calls throughout the membership year plus ad-hoc meetings.
- Willing to participate in tasks such as drafting of minutes, contacting senior investment professionals to participate on panels, helping to manage online content, organising and co-hosting events.
- Able to work with a group to shape ideas and build consensus.
- An understanding of or willingness to learn what would interest the membership.

What will you gain from volunteering in this role?

- The opportunity to liaise and network with other Manager Research professionals.
- Have a say in the organisation and management of events, and potentially lead an event if suitable.
- Be publicly recognised for your contributions to CFA UK and have the opportunity to attend a recognition event exclusive to the volunteer community.
- The opportunity to develop valuable soft skills such as teamwork, leadership, and networking.

How the CFA UK will help:

- The CFA UK will host one event each year for the SIG, including working out all the logistics (booking the venue, etc.). The LG will be responsible for sourcing the venues for and hosting the other events during the year.
- For all PRSIG events, the CFA UK can provide marketing to the Society's wider membership via the events listing and emails
- The Society can also provide support with technical operations for webinars
- In the long term the CFA UK will provide an online community platform that can be used as a tool to help build the SIG's network
