The **CFA UK Professionalism Steering Committee (“PSC”)** is a standing committee of the CFA UK Board, reporting to the Board. The PSC’s mission is to promote the advancement of professionalism within the CFA UK membership and, through advocacy outreach, the wider investment industry in order to serve the profession, society and members well.

### Purpose and Activities

As a Member your role would be to:

- Input into and approve research papers and consultation paper responses.
- Act as Gatekeeper or Group Lead for volunteer Working Groups on advocacy topics.
- Provide strategic leadership and direction to CFA UK’s professionalism plan.

And your responsibilities/activities extend to:

- Uphold the values and objectives of the PSC;
- Attend at least four out of six meetings in a year, ideally in person;
- Give adequate time and effort to member duties (reviewing advocacy letters & research papers);
- Contribute to the work of the PSC and to the fulfilment of its responsibilities;
- Show courtesy and respect to other members of the PSC.
