CFA UK are bringing a new professional learning platform to the membership. Together with CFA Institute, a framework is being constructed that identifies the skills and knowledge investment professionals need to succeed in their roles and progress through the industry. Many of the key skills identified are soft skills such as collaboration and leadership. We need your help in curating soft skills content that ensures our new platform is ready for launch.

This working group will be in close communication with the staffed office from July through to first stage product launch in September. The staffed office will provide detailed guidance on the curation policy and requirements.

Responsibilities and activities:

- Identify third party content (such as videos and articles) that offer clear educational benefit to the membership in the following areas:
 - Collaboration
 - o Emotional intelligence
 - Curiosity
 - o Personal effectiveness
- Work with the staffed office to quality check all identified pieces of content
- Approach publishers/ content originators to seek permission to use their content on the Professional Learning platform
- Deliver 10 or more pieces of relevant content per topic area

- Volunteers with a keen interest in career development skills
- Volunteers who would like to curate relevant content
- Availability to progress this work regularly in the July to September period including a kick off meeting, regular calls and ongoing communication within the group and to the staffed office.
- Ability to work with a group to shape ideas.
